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













Life expectancy at birth in Italy 2002-2024, by gender







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




#### Italy: Share of global gross domestic product (GDP) adjusted for Purchasing Power Parity (PPP) from 2019 to 2029

















Export of commodities from Italy 2023



Export value of Italy 2023, by destination country







Import of commodities to Italy 2023









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







Ratio of military expenditure to gross domestic product (GDP) in Italy 2022







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
