

Total population of Spain 2010-2029



Population growth in Spain 2023





Life expectancy in Spain 2022





Life expectancy at birth in Spain 2022, by gender



Crude birth rate of Spain, 1850-2020







Median age of the population in Spain 1950-2050












Spain: Share of global gross domestic product (GDP) adjusted for Purchasing Power Parity (PPP) from 2019 to 2029














Unemployment rate in Spain 2023

Youth unemployment rate in Spain in 2023





Export of commodities from Spain 2023













Trade balance of goods in Spain 2023















Spain: Ratio of military spending to gross domestic product (GDP) from 2012 to 2022






