





Crude birth rate in Turkey 2012-2022




Life expectancy at birth in Turkey 2022









Mortality rate in Turkey 2022 by gender

















Share of Turkey in the global GDP adjusted for purchasing power parity 2029





Share of economic sectors in gross domestic product in Turkey 2013-2023







Youth unemployment rate in Turkey in 2023









Export of commodities from Turkey 2022









Trade balance of goods of Turkey 2023


















