

Total population of Denmark 2029






Population growth in Denmark 2023



Crude birth rate in Denmark 1960-2022



Life expectancy at birth in Denmark 2022






























Unemployment rate in Denmark 2023

Youth unemployment rate in Denmark in 2023







Import of commodities to Denmark 2023


























