






Norway: Population growth from 2013 to 2023 (compared to previous year)



Fertility rate in Norway 2022







Life expectancy at birth in Norway 2012-2022



Life expectancy at birth in Norway 2022, by gender























































Unemployment rate in Norway 2023





Unemployment rate in Norway 2014-2024, by gender























Share of women in the Norwegian Parliament 1945-2021








