



Population growth in Estonia 2023








Life expectancy at birth in Estonia 2022

Life expectancy at birth in Estonia 2022, by gender











Infant mortality rate in Estonia 2022



















Unemployment rate in Estonia 2023



Estonia: Youth unemployment rate from 2004 to 2023


Youth unemployment rate in Estonia in 2023





Most important import partners of Estonia 2023













National debt of Estonia in relation to gross domestic product (GDP) 2029












